**JOB SUMMARY:**

The Homemaker reports to the Site Manager and works in accordance with the mission and philosophy of Lookout Housing and Health Society including following Lookout's Code of Ethics. The Homemaker performs a variety of cleaning duties ensuring the cleanliness and tidiness of resident and/or shelter rooms and communal areas.

**JOB DUTIES (In Brief):**

- Clean rooms, change and make beds, do laundry, keep supplies organized and stocked, keep personal care supplies organized.
- General cleaning, laundry, washing, and disinfecting areas such as walls, windows, ceilings, floors, carpets, air vents, furniture, mattresses, blinds, and washrooms.
- Organize donations and oversee and direct volunteers.
- Assist clientele with personal hygiene and nutrition as needed.

- Minimum Grade 12 education plus one (1) year of recent related experience; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience
- **Must have current Occupational First Aid Level 1 Certificate**
